DESCRIPTION: Our Pinot Noir comes from distinct vineyards throughout Oregon. We look for sites that give us diversity, low elevation for ripeness and intensity, high elevation for acidity and aromatics. From Walla Walla to Dundee to Melrose, Oregon, these sites allow us to create this truly Oregon Pinot Noir.

TASTING NOTES: The Underwood Pinot Noir exhibits aromas of cherry and spice, with subtle hints of vanilla. The palate is loaded with ripe dark fruit, cherry and blueberry, with great balance lending to a long finish.
